We are still in need of \$800 to finish the roof. After, we will start to finish the inside of the building by installing doors,



windows and preparing the walls to be painted. To complete this step, we will need approximately \$5000. Will you consider helping?

Plans are being made for this summer's missions trip to Pestel. We will be traveling July 11-17th. This is an excellent opportunity for you to experience life in Haiti for yourself.

Unlike other missions trips, the team will

stay right in the midst of the Pestel community with a local Haitian family. We will work during the morning on the library building along with our Haitian workers. We hope to be painting the inner walls! Local churches are coordinating a series of revival meetings that will take place at the library while we are there. We will be able to participate as well as conduct other outreaches within the community such as children's meetings and visitations. The cost is approximately \$1700.
